1. Police would like to make you aware of the following scam which has occurred in your area. Caller claiming to be from Talk Talk offering to fix your computer; they gain remote access to your computer by software known as Team Viewer. The scam caller offered the victim compensation because of the inconvenience and asked the victim to type in their bank details on their computer - this was a scam to defraud monies.
